I am requesting funding for the East Antioch Creek Outfall Improvements Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Antioch, located at 200 H Street, Antioch, CA, 94509. The funding would be used to replace two storm drainpipes with flapper gates, reconstruct a compromised sanitary sewer pipeline, and stabilize erosion-prone soils beneath a key access roadway along the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it is a proactive investment in the Delta region to prevent more costly repairs, ensure public infrastructure stability, and safeguard water quality in the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta ecosystem.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. § 5305(a)(2).
