I write today on behalf of the Peace Officers Research Association of California (PORAC), representing approximately 80,000 public safety members and 955 public safety associations across our State. PORAC is pleased to support your legislation, the *Investing in Community Safety Act of 2023* (H.R. 4246), which would amend the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to authorize the use of COPS grants for recruitment efforts.

Every day, the men and women of state and local law enforcement risk their lives, fearlessly protecting their communities from the rising tide of violent crime. However, the dedication and sacrifices of these officers are strained as police departments across the nation grapple with overwhelming responsibilities and dwindling resources.
